1. Women's Rights National Historical Park and Visitor's Center, Chapel, Elizabeth Cady Stanton Home (free)
2. It's a Wonderful Life Museum; Sat and Sun 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM; Free
This is the **71st Anniversary Celebration of "It's A Wonderful Life"**. Expected in town are Karolyn Grimes (Zuzu), Jimmy Hawkins (Tommy), Jeanine Roose (Young Violet Bick), and Carol Coomes (Janie Bailey). This is the first time four actors from the movie will attend the Seneca Falls celebration.
3. Seneca Falls Historical Society; normally closed on Sunday, may be open Sunday for the celebration. Open Saturday. The fee (\$10-15) is usually waived for the weekend celebration.
4. National Women's Hall of Fame; \$1.50 (age 65+)
5. Free Shuttle Bus to High School for the Saturday, "Dance by the Light of the Moon" Dance. (Orchestra and Fun)
6. Parade: Saturday afternoon; followed by a 5K run.
7. The Cobblestone Restaurant: Saturday, sit down dinner
8. Sunday evening (6:00 – 9:00): "Welcome Home, Harry Bailey" Dinner celebrating the final scene from the movie. Seneca Falls Country Club
9. The Bells of the Real Bedford Falls: The message is that each person has value and everyone makes a difference. An angel is sent at the right time. With a \$20 donation, you get a certificate and the bell will be rung as we remember those without whom our world would be a different place.
